## Publication Charges

As the traditional model of journal publishing depends on restricting access to published research in order to recoup the costs of the publication process, the Open Access publishing model depends on the publishing Authors to recoup the costs. Instead of charging readers a fee to read the content, Publication Charge is levied to the Authors. To continue to provide high-quality, peer-reviewed articles without charge to readers on the web – ensuring that articles receive the highest exposure and potential impact associated with open access publishing, IASTER requires a nominal Publication Charge.

This flat charge, which varies from journal to journal, covers the cost of the publication process, which includes - Cost of Review Process, Copy Editing, Electronic Composition, Online & Print Publications, Journal Information System, Manuscript Management System, Long Term Electronic Archiving, Indexing and Abstracting for various Search Engines, Citation, Mailing Costs of Journal's Hardcopy, Overhead Expenses and Administrative Costs etc.

Moreover, apart from covering the costs of publishing the accepted manuscripts, we must also cover the reviewing cost of the manuscripts, which IASTER rejects.

By submitting a manuscript to an IASTER's Open Access Journal for publication, the submitting Author agrees to pay the publication charge minus any eligible waiver besides agreeing Copyright Transfer Agreement terms and other general terms and conditions of IASTER. After acceptance, the manuscript will enter the publication process and the author will be asked to pay the publication charge for the journal, minus any eligible waiver. Please see the Waiver Eligibility conditions below. Payment of the publication charge must be received by IASTER before the manuscript is published online and followed by print version.

## Payment of Publication Charges by Indian Authors

Following are different ways of paying the publication charges of accepted articles. Authors can choose anyone option to make the payment according to his/her convenience. The applicable charges of the transferring bank/agency, if any, are to be paid by the Authors directly to the bank/agency as the publication charges given do not include such charges. Authors are requested to send scanned copy of publication fee receipt by mail for timely publication of their papers.

### NEFT Transfer through Online

While communicating the acceptance of the manuscript for publication, author will receive the details of the bank account, to which the payment has to be made. Author or his representative can use their online net banking account for transferring the Publication Charges through National Electronic Funds Transfer (NEFT) using the bank details provided in the acceptance mail or visit your bank branch and get the transfer done.

### Depositing in a nearby Bank Branch

Author can deposit the publication charges directly in the bank account number given in our acceptance mail by way of Cash/Cheque/Demand Draft by visiting a nearby branch of the said bank.

### By way of Demand Draft/Cheque

When the Author wants to make payment by way of Demand Draft or by Cheque, the same has to be drawn in favour of "IASTER Foundation", payable at "COIMBATORE". This has to be sent to our Back Office / Registered Office at IASTER, No.1, Thoppil Nagar, Coimbatore 641046, India.

## Payment of Publication Charges by Foreign Authors

Authors from outside India can pay the publication charges using one of the options given below. The applicable charges of the transferring bank/agency, if any, are to be paid by the Authors directly to the bank/agency as the publication charges given do not include such charges. Authors are requested to send scanned copy of publication fee receipt by mail for timely publication of their papers.

### Wire Transfer

While communicating the acceptance of the manuscript for publication, author will receive the details of the bank account, to which the payment has to be made. Author or his representative can use their online net banking account for transferring the Publication Charges through Online Wire Transfer (also called as SWIFT transfer) by using SWIFT code which will be given in the acceptance mail.

### Western Union Money Transfer

Authors can send the publication charges by using the services of Western Union. Receiver details will be given in the acceptance mail. Once the payment has been made please send the below details

- First and last name of the sender
- First and last name of the Receiver
- City and country from where the money has been sent
- Total Amount sent
- Money Transfer Control Number (MTCN)

### Money Gram

Authors can send the publication charges by using Money Gram. Receiver details will be given in the acceptance mail. Once the payment has been made please send the below details:

- First and last name of the sender
- First and last name of the Receiver
- City and country from where the money has been sent
- Total Amount sent
- Money Gram Reference Number
